Dear Madam, Sir,

It is with great pleasure that I write this letter of reference in support of Traian Chereches's application to the residency at the Rijksakademie in Amsterdam. I took interest in Traian's work since last year, when he participated in the emerging talent platform Salon de Montrouge, Paris. There, he impressed with his coherence in transmitting ideas of creation and destruction in between mediums, drawing and sculpture-paintings. His works, such as Eruption Destruction, capture the cosmic vibration of matter.

As another means to express the vibrations of matter, he uses sound. Sound is the key element of reduction to, and connection with, primordial elements of the Earth, emotions and body frequencies in his works. Even more, the sculptural medium in his practice is shaped by sound as an abstracting of the essential vortexes -creation, sexuality, annihilation, re-birth. His approach often evokes the in between space, both symbolically and physically.

The force in Traian's works is matched by a great sensibility characteristic to his personality and to the way in which he experiences reality.

Lately, Traian has been more eager to translate the ideas of contraction, metamorphosis and mutation that permeate his works in exploring the processes of the planet, including the accumulation of waste and the aggression of nature. Some of his art works are recycling objects by addition or division, starting to be subtly critical of these processes.

I believe the residency to be the perfect opportunity, and timely support, in this moment of his career, when, building on what exists, he can question and bring closer to us some of the most essential questions of our time: how can we pay more attention to the essential? What is essential? How do we slow down the fast-pace of our virtual and artificial realities? I fully believe in the potential of Traian's practice to evolve in this direction and I honestly hope you will grant him the chance to realize this potential!


